In 2015, the Oil Search Foundation was established to ensure Oil Search's social investment programs maximised opportunities to deliver sustainable outcomes and achieve real improvements in social indicators.

Five years on, the Foundation has worked with partners to achieve sustainable and lasting results that are changing lives in PNG. These include: improved health services for over one million people, providing case management and safe house services for survivors of family and sexual violence, and boosted literacy levels of over 500 children through literacy libraries. The Foundation has also leveraged more than USD \$29 million to support development programs in PNG's Gulf, Southern Highlands, and Hela provinces as well as the National Capital District.
